JOINT PURCHASING

- We will use PPE as a test case for future collaboration.
- o This will start in the new budget cycle
- o All 3 districts moving towards Fire-Dex Gear
- Each District will have its spec, but buy together

• TOWN WIDE FLEET MECHANIC

- We have the largest fleet in Region 1 without a dedicated mechanic.
- 9 Engines, 3 Rescues, 3 Ladders, 2 Mini Pumpers, 11 Command Cars, pickups, etc.
- o Can service small equipment, saws, generators, etc.
- o Can perform ladder testing
- Reduce downtime

HIGHWAY "CRASH" TRUCK

- o Joint Venture between all three districts
- o 1 or 2 vehicles to be operated by all three districts
- Will respond to all Limited Access highway calls townwide
- o Minimize the danger of losing apparatus
- o Greenwich, Norwalk, and other FDs already have these in motion
- o CT State DOT highly recommends this equipment instead of Fire Apparatus
- o 125k 135k per vehicle readily available vs 1.4 million and 4 years
- Working on a grant

MISC ITEMS

- Overall low staffing townwide. What can we do and how can we help?
- Multi-department access for firefighters in good standing in the "home dept". Meaning if you are near a station that isn't yours or hanging out at a sister department, you should be able to jump on their truck to staff it no matter who is dispatched.
- One townwide insurance policy which each district pays for their portion. This would assist with the comment above.
- O What is the status of TFSS? Who covers them if they are to get injured on our fire scene?
- o Facility Maintenance Managers
- Townwide wet down for new trucks at NFD, TCFD, LHFD? Any interest?
